ASTM-SEI Approved Helmets: Required for all jumping classes. Classes may be canceled or combined with less than 4 entries. No refunds. Awards: Ribbons to sixth place for all classes. Championship and Reserve Championship Ribbons for halter. Show Ring: 200' x 300' sand ring. Sand and grass warm-up areas. Stabling: 46 temporary stalls 8' x 10" heavy wood with doors. Limited 10' x 10' permanent stalls with doors. Food: Concession on grounds: D.O.G.S. Kitchen serving breakfast and lunch. Accommodations: Park International 269-429-3218; Baymont Inn 269-428-9111; Ramada Inn 269-927-1172; Days Inn 269-925-7021. More hotels/motels contact show manager or check web site. Camping on grounds is limited and no hook-ups. Dogs must be on a leash. Negative Coggins: Test Required taken after January 1, 2009. Must bring copy of Coggins and Breed papers to registration. Directions: Located SW corner of Michigan. From I-94: John Beers Rd. exit 22; east thru downtown Stevensville to Washington Ave.; turn South on Washington Ave. and continue approx. 0.5 miles; farm is on West side of road. From US-12: North on Cleveland Ave. at Galien, approx. 14 miles; turn East on Linco, approx. 0.5 miles first crossroad is Washington; turn North; go approx. 0.5 miles, farm is on West side of road. From US-31 Bypass: Exit 15 B; North towards St. Joseph, MI; turn West on Linco, approx. 5 miles to Washington Ave.; turn North; go approx. 0.5 miles, farm is on West side of road.
